REDUCED RATE RECYCLING & ORGANICS - 2 YARDS OR MORE

Recycling service is provided at no additional charge to Albany businesses and multi-family dwellings. Organics service is provided to Albany businesses and multi-family dwellings at a 50% discount off of regular trash rates. Multi-family dwellings with cart service for trash receive organics service at no additional charge. Waste Management is the exclusive provider of trash, recycling, and organics collection services in Albany.

LAMPTRACKER PROGRAM TO RECYCLE CFL BULBS

To protect your health and the environment, California law requires that compact fluorescent light (CFL) bulbs be properly disposed. Waste Management offers a simple solution: Collect bulbs in LampTracker's Mercury VaporLok bag and mail them back in the provided pre-paid postage box. It's that easy. Visit WM.com.



HAZARDOUS WASTE

HHW (Household Hazardous Waste) such as paints, pesticides, fertilizers, compact fluorescent lights (CFLs), electronics, propane tanks and cleaners) is not allowed in the trash, recycling or green waste containers. MANDATORY RECYCLING & ORGANICS

All businesses, institutions, and multi-family properties with five or more units located in Albany must comply with Alameda County Waste Management Authority (ACWMA)'s Mandatory Recycling & Organics Ordinance by subscribing to adequate trash, recycling, and organics collection services.

Businesses and institutions must also ensure materials are sorted properly, including recyclables (paper and cardboard, paper, glass, metal, and plastic containers) and organics (food scraps, food-soiled paper, and plant debris).

Drink & food cartons, boxes / pouches (Multi-material Packaging)



Loose plastic bags/wrap, disposable gloves



Broken glassware & ceramics, plastic straws, lids & utensils (Reusable items should be donated)



Coated paper products, waxed cardboard



Hoses & wires



Polystyrene foam



Clean paper & cardboard (please break down)



Paper packaging



Glass bottles & jars



Cans, foil, & scrap metal



Plastic bottles



Rigid plastic containers



All food waste, peels, pits, & cores



Bones & shells



Plant debris & clean wood



Coffee grounds & tea bags



Uncoated Paper take-out & pizza boxes, egg cartons

Avoid an Overage Charge

Materials must fit inside a container with the lid shut for regular service or you may be charged.

If you regularly have excess materials, call Customer Service at (510) 613-8700 to help you right-size your service.



Recyclables should be empty, clean, dry, and loose. Place them directly in your recycle bin.

Compost Food-Soiled & Shredded Paper

In addition to food scraps, make sure to compost all food-soiled, stained, or wet paper. Paper towels, napkins, tissues, pizza boxes and shredded paper should always go in your green cart.

Tip: Compost shredded paper, confidential mail, and pizza boxes to absorb moisture in your organics bin.


