




# Deconstruction Trainings

## **Training Inmates**

- 1 overview training
- 1 intensive training
  - for exoffenders, parolees, those who have a work furlough or are in transitional housing
  - 25 people who are work furlough approved to work a full time job
  - have to get themselves to training so we should consider driving them
  - take advantage of getting a job while in a structured environment



#### **Overview Trainings**

- 1st day classroom
  - The benefits of deconstruction
  - Tools and equipment
  - Layout of the jobsite
  - Materials handling and shipping
  - Maintaining salvage values
  - Review of tax-deductible donations for salvaged materials
- 2<sup>nd</sup> day jobsite visit and classroom wrap up
  - Identification of salvageable materials
  - How salvaged materials are removed and handled
  - Cost considerations and bidding

#### **Intensive Trainings**

- Day 1 in the classroom
  - o tools, safety, fixtures, etc.
  - o quiz
- Days 2-3 in the field
  - learn about removing things like sinks, toilets, etc.
- Days 3-4 are in the classroom
  - o talk about what they did right and wrong in the field work
  - o talk about framing removal and banding lumber
  - o quiz
- Take house down through day 11
- Day 12 in the classroom
  - o wrap up
  - o test
  - certificates
  - o graduation

### **Optional Crew Chief Training**

- 1<sup>st</sup> day in the classroom
- 2<sup>nd</sup> day to walk through a vacant house
  - look at costs
  - o time
  - o managing the crew
  - o conflict resolution
