✘ No: Trash, Food Waste and Food-Soiled Paper (Paper Towels and Napkins, Paper Cups and Plates, Pizza Boxes), Styrofoam Containers, Plates or Cups, Flexible Foam, Treated Wood, Pallets, Landscape Waste or Plant Debris, Restroom Waste, Hazardous or Medical Waste, Construction Debris, Concrete, Asphalt, Dirt, Shoes, Clothing or Textiles, Diapers

Yard Waste, All Food Scraps and Some Food-Soiled Paper



✘ No: Plastic or Plastic Bags, Glass, Metals or Foil, Liquids, Oil/Grease, Diapers, Restroom Waste, Pet Waste or Cat Litter, Palm Fronds, Cactus, Tree Stumps, Dirt/Sod, Plastic-Coated Paper Products (Plates or Cups), Single Serve Coffee Pods, Hazardous Waste or Garbage.
